You can often treat the symptoms yourself by keeping warm. Sometimes it can be a sign of a more serious condition. Check if it's Raynaud's. Raynaud's affects your blood circulation. When you're cold, anxious or stressed, your fingers and toes may change colour.

Raynaud's - NHS

Raynaud's (ray-NOSE) disease causes some areas of your body — such as your fingers and toes — to feel numb and cold in response to cold temperatures or stress. In Raynaud's disease, smaller arteries that supply blood to your skin become narrow, limiting blood flow to affected areas (vasospasm). Women are more likely than men to have Raynaud's disease, also known as Raynaud's or Raynaud's phenomenon or syndrome.

This happens mainly when you get cold, and it can also happen because of stressful situations. It most commonly affects fingers and toes, but can sometimes also affect lips, noses, ears and nipples.

If you have severe Raynaud's, your doctor may recommend surgery or injections. Nerve surgery. Sympathetic nerves in your hands and feet control the opening and narrowing of blood vessels in your skin. Cutting these nerves interrupts their exaggerated responses.

In people who have Raynaud ' s, the small blood vessels in the extremities are over-sensitive to changes in temperature. This causes a Raynaud ' s attack where the fingers sometimes change colour (but not always) from white, to blue, to red. Sometimes the fingers may become painful or have a tingling sensation during the event.

Secondary Raynaud ' s is caused by an underlying disease, condition, or other factor. This type of Raynaud's is often called Raynaud's phenomenon.
